MESSAGE FROM FATHER/ MENSAJE DEL PADRE

Dear Friends,

As we are on the 3rd Easter Sunday, let us draw wisdom from the gospel passage that provides invaluable insights into managing crises.

Imagine the scene: Jesus, risen from the dead, stands before his disciples who are grappling with uncertainties and anxieties. Having scattered during his crucifixion, they relied on hearsay to understand his fate, save for John, who witnessed the events firsthand. Jesus seeks to dispel any doubts about his return by presenting himself physically. He shows them his wounds, invites them to touch him, and shares a meal, affirming his tangible existence.

This encounter is transformative, marking a new phase in Christianity. Jesus' actions offer profound lessons in crisis management, emphasizing the importance of confronting reality and embracing truth. By acknowledging reality as it is, individuals find liberation and foster reconciliation.

Jesus extends a message of peace, saying, "Peace be with you." This phrase isn't mere words; it's an invitation to find serenity amid turmoil. It reassures them that despite chaos, God remains in control, bringing comfort and hope.

"Peace be with you" carries deeper significance, symbolizing both a blessing and a challenge. It signifies wholeness and prompts believers to embody peace actively.

Forgiveness is another vital aspect of Jesus' teachings. He emphasizes forgiveness for enduring peace. Reflecting on the cries of "crucify him," Jesus underscores that genuine peace arises through forgiveness. It liberates from sin's cycle, leading to transformation.

Jesus' message inspires hope, disrupting hate and fear. These teachings serve as guidelines for navigating challenges with grace, resilience, and compassion.

As we reflect, let's embody forgiveness, seek peace, and embrace truth. Let the transformative power of Christ's resurrection guide us through life's storms.

May the peace of the Risen Christ be with you all.
