# MESSAGE FROM FATHER WILSON

Dear Friends in Christ,

**Man has never grown used to the idea of death.** On the contrary, as Christians we profess in the Apostles' Creed: "I believe in the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting." For a faithful Christian, "life is changed, not ended." That is why although it is challenging, we can accept it with serenity.

The doubts of the Sadducees from our Gospel are real life and death questions. **What would happen if there were nothing after death except emptiness, solitude?** This is the exciting road of the Resurrection just waiting to be explained to them. The Pharisees, meanwhile, were hoping for a Messianic peace. They loved to meditate on the passage Christ referred to in Exodus 3:6, *"the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob is not a God of the dead but a God of the living, because for him all are alive."*

**But all this doesn't seem to mean much to modern man.** And that is the real problem. A problem that has become too serious. Today's society is superficial and pleasure-seeking. Too many people are absorbed with playing games, watching games and buying things. Pope Benedict XVI warned us that "some people live as though they would never die or as if everything ended in death; and other behave as though man were the sole maker of his own destiny, as though God didn't exist." That is why I want you to make a pause in the midst of your daily routine and ask yourself these existential questions: Why do I exist? Where did I come from? What's going to happen after I die?

Christ gives us the answer in the Gospel. This is part of revelation, confirmed by the Magisterium: Christ has risen! We have been incorporated into Christ; **if he has risen, as we are faithful, we also will be raised.** If not, our faith is in vain. And if our faith is in vain, what meaning would our life have? Could there be a simpler way to see what is so far beyond us? And what lesson can we learn from all this for our Christian life?

If Christ has risen, then there is something more here that transcends us, something we cannot see. **Let us seek the things that are above!** The Eucharist that we receive is a "seed of immortality" in our souls. "May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God and to the steadfastness of Christ." (II Thess 3:5)
