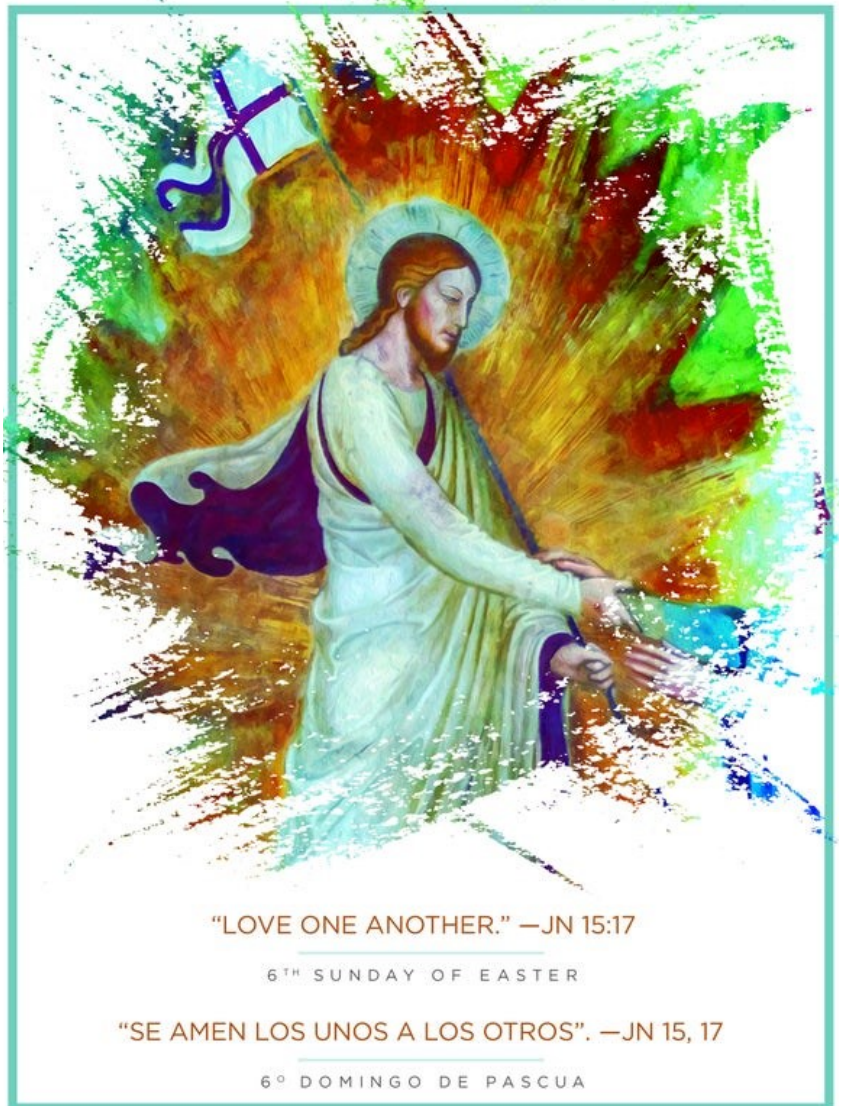

MESSAGE FROM FATHER/ MENSAJE DEL PADRE

Dear OLP Family,

Blessed Sunday! I wish to inform you that our parish is seeking a qualified bookkeeper. You can find the necessary information in this week's bulletin, on our website, the diocesan website, and other job portals. If you feel qualified, please apply. We hope to find the right person for this role, and we kindly ask for your prayers for this intention.

Let's reflect on this Sunday's Gospel reading. In the Gospel, Jesus showed his disciples that he is their friend as well as their master by washing their feet.

Jesus enjoyed three types of friendships: with himself, with his 12 disciples, and with many others.

Friendship with himself: Jesus understood who he was, though some disciples had difficulty understanding. The best friend we will ever find is ourselves. Jesus knew what a friend he was to himself, and he revealed to Thomas, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." His Father is his other self.

Friendship with his disciples: Jesus had 12 disciples, each with different personalities. He spent most of his time with them, training them to become like him. He allowed them to be with him and to experience him fully. He never hid anything from them and even warned them openly about their future denial and betrayal. A true friend is one who knows you and still loves you.

Friendship with many others: Jesus befriended people from all walks of life, including those on the fringes of society. For instance, his longest recorded conversation in the Gospel was with a Samaritan woman. He loved and guided others, such as Zacchaeus, Mary Magdalene, and Lazarus. He was a faithful friend, never abandoning or betraying his friends, and defended them against unjust criticism.

Friendships are crucial for a church's community. A Pew survey points out that people often leave churches not because of the preaching or programs, but because they don't feel a sense of belonging. We need to show love for one another, building relationships that make the church stronger.

What a friend we have in Jesus.

Reflexionemos sobre la lectura del Evangelio de este domingo. En el Evangelio, Jesús mostró a sus discípulos que él es tanto su amigo como su maestro lavándoles los pies.

Jesús disfrutó de tres tipos de amistades: consigo mismo, con sus 12 discípulos y con muchos otros.

Amistad consigo mismo: Jesús entendió quién era, aunque algunos discípulos tuvieron dificultades para entenderlo. El mejor amigo que jamás encontraremos somos nosotros mismos. Jesús sabía lo amigo que era para sí mismo y le reveló a Tomás: "Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida. Nadie viene al Padre sino por mí". Su Padre es su otro yo.

Amistad con sus discípulos: Jesús tuvo 12 discípulos, cada uno con personalidades diferentes. Pasó la mayor parte de su tiempo con ellos, entrenándolos para que fueran como él. Les permitió estar con él y experimentarlo plenamente. Nunca les ocultó nada e incluso les advirtió abiertamente sobre su futura negación y traición. Un verdadero amigo es aquel que te conoce y aún te ama.

Amistad con muchos otros: Jesús se hizo amigo de personas de todos los ámbitos de la vida, incluidos aquellos que estaban al margen de la sociedad. Por ejemplo, su conversación más larga registrada en el Evangelio fue con una mujer samaritana. Amaba y guiaba a otros, como Zaqueo, María Magdalena y Lázaro. Fue un amigo fiel, nunca abandonó ni traicionó a sus amigos y los defendió de críticas injustas.

Las amistades son cruciales para la comunidad de una iglesia. Una encuesta de Pew señala que la gente a menudo abandona las iglesias no por la predicación o los programas, sino porque no tienen un sentido de pertenencia. Necesitamos mostrar amor unos por otros, construyendo relaciones que fortalezcan a la iglesia.

Qué amigo que tenemos en Jesús.
