# MESSAGE FROM FATHER WILSON

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today's readings are a wake-up call to our conscience; all of us must learn to place temporal goods in their proper place and use them intelligently. There are people who make material wealth the main motive behind their activities and even their life; that's all they think about. They make money into an idol on whose altar they sacrifice their values, their family and even their own health.

We find two attitudes. In the world, the prudent man is the one who stores up money. Jesus calls this attitude "serving money," while it would be more prudent for us to put it to good use. That is why he stunningly declares, **"You cannot serve God and money."** Miserly people are always unhappy, perpetual hostages that take pleasure neither in the world nor in God. They isolate themselves and don't have feelings, not even for those of their own flesh who see them as people only out for their own gain.

In life we will always need to choose between opposing values, but we can only choose the best. And choosing one thing means renouncing its opposite. If on the one hand we have God's commandments and on the other we have material things, there can be no doubt: **only God is worth risking everything for.** Our Lord asks us to renounce everything to serve him alone; and our heart cannot be divided. It must belong to God fully and at all times.

This Gospel passage invites us to be faithful to God. **We cannot be slaves of wealth; rather we must learn to use it responsibly.** Material goods will be useful only if we use them to help our neighbors in greatest need. This is the only way we can make money a means of communion with other people, instead of a means of discrimination.

Material wealth is a bad boss, but we can make it a good servant. That is the secret of faithful stewards. Christians are poor at heart and can't be at peace blindly enjoying earthly goods while there are needy people at hand. **Our secret is living the law of love.**

True charity doesn't mean just giving alms to those who ask at the doors of the church, nor buying a ticket for a benefit dinner. It must go further, for example, being honest in paying taxes, creating new jobs, being more generous with my employee's salaries, in other words, making our money benefit the needy. "You cannot serve God and mammon." Our Lord will reward our faithfulness.

This weekend Father Matthew Palkowski, OFM Cap. is glad to have the opportunity to visit our parish on behalf of Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). Fr. Matthew is a Capuchin Franciscan Friar from the St. Augustine (Pittsburgh) Province. He was born in Detroit MI. He received an undergraduate degree in Finance in 1982 from Michigan

State University and his graduate degree in Theology, an STB, from the Catholic University of America in 1989. He worked at the Smithsonian before entering the Capuchins. Fr. Matthew served as Parochial Vicar at the Shrine of the Sacred Heart in Washington DC and at St. John's in Philadelphia. He was a Hospital Chaplain in Harrisburg, PA. He was also the Chaplain at the City Jail in Philadelphia and invited the Pope to visit the inmates when the Pope came to the City Jail in Philadelphia in 2015. He is currently working with Catholic Charities of Southeast Michigan and is developing a community-based re-entry program as well as working with older adults who have dementia. He is interested in a Theology of Beauty as a particularly Franciscan approach to Theology. FOCUS is a national organization serving college students at more than 203 campus/locations including six international locations, 22 parish venues and 7 digital expansion campuses. Almost 850 FOCUS missionaries invite college students into a relationship with Christ and His Church, while equipping them for a lifetime of Catholic evangelization. Fr.
